How to Tag Crochet for Social Handcraft...

- Attach a small tag to the crochet object (anything goes)
- Write the name on the tag
- Update the <u>crochet log</u> with the name that matches your tag

Here's the naming protocol:

YourName + FancifulName + Number*

*based on how many pieces you've made

Example 1. AdlerLichenBlob1

The number will help us track down your pieces if you send multiples.

Example 2. If I'd made 40 pieces of crochet, my next piece might be named something like, *AdlerTreeSpit41*

Example 3. "Hey, Kyla – I have JacksonWriggleLump23 and JacksonPurpleDude25, but no 24. Did we lose something???"

You can use whatever name or version of your name you'd like. That's the name we'll credit, so please choose with that in mind. If you'd prefer to remain anonymous, that's fine too. We'll just need an e-mail address if you want your crochet returned.

We understand that you probably want to avoid taking more computer work into your life. We feel the same and are blowing you all kinds of virtual kisses for sharing this essential administrative work with us. Nothing says 'I care for you' like a voluntary spreadsheet entry. You are the best.
